School Referendum Presentation, it is needed to do major repair to buildings. Will potentially reduce taxes by \$1 per \$1000. They are rolling a loan that has been paid off over.

After discussion it was tabled until April to request from R1 to R2 as the board feels that will be a better fit for neighbor and still allow what the landowner wants to do.
